Project S.H.I.F.T (Securing Help in Family Transportation) provides vehicles to low-income, working families in transitional housing programs across the Valley. While in the program, families make affordable, monthly payments (\$180-\$200) on the vehicle, eventually owning after 24 payments have been made.

- Realistic purchase options
- Establish achievable goals
- Access resources
- Improve quality of life

Eligible families must be:

- Parents of children under the age of 18
 - Currently homeless or formally homeless within the past year
 - Employed with proof of income
 - Financially responsible, earning less than 80% of AMI
 - Recommended by a Case Manager (if applicable)
 - Motivated to increase job earning wage
